NOTICE OF SCOPING AND PUBLIC INVOLVEMENT UNDER THE NATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY ACT FOR THE PROPOSED WILLAMETTE NATIONAL CEMETERY DEVELOPMENT PROJECT IN MARION COUNTY, OREGON; VA NEPA ID # EAXX-029-40-NCA-1756327369

To fulfill its mission to honor Veterans and ensure continued interment availability, the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) has determined that there is a need to expand Veteran burial options within the Willamette Valley region (Figure 1). VA's Proposed Action is to acquire approximately 300 acres of land located at 3515 Howell Prairie Road Southeast, Salem, Oregon to replace the existing Willamette National Cemetery (Figure 2). The additional land will support the development of future gravesites and facilities to meet the National Cemetery Administration's goal of providing eligible Veterans and their family members with reasonable access to VA interment options. These benefits are provided by VA under the National Cemetery Act of 1973 and Chapter 24 of Title 38, United States Code.

VA is preparing an environmental assessment (EA) to assess the potential environmental impacts of the Proposed Action. VA is seeking input from stakeholders as part of the scoping process in the development of this document. VA is preparing the EA in accordance with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) of 1969 (42 U.S.C. § 4321-4370) and VA's NEPA regulations (38 C.F.R. Part 26).

Through this notice, VA is also providing the public with information about the undertaking and seeking public comment and input about the undertaking's effects on historic properties pursuant to Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended, (54 U.S.C. § 306108), and its implementing regulations (36 C.F.R. Part 800 – Protection of Historic Properties). VA is using its procedures for public involvement under NEPA in lieu of public involvement requirements in Subpart B of the Section 106 regulations per 36 C.F.R. 800.2(d)(3). This notice does not serve as an invitation to consult under Section 106; it is solely to seek and consider the views of the public. VA will initiate its Section 106 review and send invitations to consulting parties separately.
