**Notice of 15-Day Public Comment Period, Public Hearing for**  
**2024 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER)**

The City of Salem Community Planning and Development Department is making the 2024 CAPER available for public review and comment for 15 days beginning on September 8, 2025 and ending on September 23, 2025.

**Information about the CAPER:**

The City of Salem annually receives two grants from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD):

- **Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)**
- **Home Investment Partnership (HOME)**

The CAPER describes how the grant funds were expended from July 1, 2024 to June 30, 2025 to carry out the housing, homeless and community development objectives, strategies and activities outlined in the City's 2020 Annual Action Plan and substantial amendments.
