

**NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SALEM, OREGON
TOURISM PROMOTION AREA CONTINUATION**

The Salem City Council will host a public hearing on Monday, March 9, 2026, at 6:00 p.m. to receive testimony regarding the continuation of the Tourism Promotion Area (TPA).

Those who would like to remonstrate (“object”) against the continuation of the TPA must be an operator of an accessory short-term rental, short-term rental, hotel/motel or any facility that provides transient lodging under Salem Revised Code Chapter 38. Operators are entitled to one objection for each separate unit available for transient lodging for a minimum of 60 days prior to the date of the public hearing. To object, operators must provide in writing their name, address of their transient lodging property or properties and the number of units which they have available for rent. The City may require proof of these available units and their rent terms. Written objections can be sent to City of Salem’s Finance Office, 440 Church Street SE, Salem, Oregon, 97301 or via email at finance@cityofsalem.net by March 3, 2026, at 5PM. After that time, written objections can be sent to the City Recorder at the City of Salem’s Recorder Office, 440 Church Street SE, Salem, Oregon, 97301 or via email at cityrecorder@cityofsalem.net by March 9, 2026, at 5:00 p.m. All written objections must be received by the end of the public hearing on March 9, 2026.
