

30 Day Notice of Public Comment for Consolidated Plan

The 2025-2029 Housing and Community Development Consolidated Plan (Consolidated Plan), required for the City of Salem to receive funds from the U.S Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) is available for a 30-day public comment period beginning June 28, 2025. The Consolidated Plan provides a guide for determining Salem's federal funding priorities over the next five years. The priority categories proposed in the 2025-2029 Consolidated Plan are as follows:

1. Provide Decent Housing
2. Create a Suitable Living Environment
3. Expand Opportunities for Low-to-Moderate Income Persons

The goals of the plan are:

1. Administration and Planning
2. Public Services
3. Housing
4. Public Facilities and Neighborhood Improvements
5. Economic and Asset Development

The plan is also available for viewing at the City Library, West Salem Library, Center 50+, and the Community and Planning Development Department. Residents may have a copy of the plan for the cost of copying as set forth the City's fee schedule.

HUD requires communities receiving federal funds to prepare an Analysis of Impediments to Fair Housing (AI). This analysis reviews the community's laws, administrative procedures, and other practices that restrict housing choice in Salem. The AI is also available during this 30-day public comment period.

Public Hearing

The Salem City Council will hold a public hearing at 6:00 p.m., Monday, July 14, 2025 for the purpose of receiving public comment on the proposed plan at Loucks Auditorium, 585 Liberty Street SE, Salem OR 97301.
